A. Activities`

➤ Provision of legal aid and Counseling

Legal aid and Counseling was provided to 33 clients visited CRC center, Women 31, Men zero. Children 2 Reconciliation was done to 3 clients through direct conversation, the rest cases were finished as they were supported with the legal aid and counseling needed.

➤ Reconciliation

Reconciliation was done to three clients under GEWE Project through direct conversation and out of three reconciliations, one was done successful, the other one is ongoing and the last is failed but they were advised to go to Kinondoni Social Welfare for further step

➤ Support

Capital support was given to one client from Kimara, under GEWE Project to facilitate the cost of valuation fees of the matrimonial house which is ordered by the court to be distributed to the spouses equally.

➤ Follow up on victim's cases

Total number of follow up was done to five clients through visitation two under IOGT Project and three under GEWE Project, phone calls follow up were done to four clients, all under GEWE Project
