1.0 Activities:

1.1 Provision of legal aid and Counseling

Legal aid and Counseling were provided to 40 clients who visited at CRC Center. Women were 31, Men were 5 while Children were 4

1.2 Reconciliation

Reconciliation was done to 3 clients through direct conversation and out of 3 reconciliations, 2 were successful, and 1 on going.

1.3 Support to clients

Support was not given to any client from both IOGT and GEWE current projects

1.4 Follow up on victim's cases

Total number of follow up was done to clients. Nine (9), 4 among them was through visitation and other 5 was through phone call.

1.5 LCF- Activities

Monitoring follow-up in 3 IP's implementations areas with Media Engagement Strategy (MES).

The monitoring activity was intended to meet with project stakeholders and see how they implement media engagement strategy.

The overall objective of the technical support and consultancy service is to strengthen performance of Legal Service Facility (LSF) implementing partners and stakeholders through regular monitoring of the implementation of media engagement.

1.6 Road Safety Project

On 27th July, 2016 TAMWA in a collaboration with CRC launched a project titled 'Building public awareness creation of road safety crisis in Tanzania'. The

project shall mainly working with training to journalists on how to report issues related to Road Safety as a public information and knowledge. Also, by using electronic media outlets TAMWA/CRC shall prepare programs in collaboration with radio/TV producers on the same issues. Main targets are the community in general and specifically women and children who are the major users of road.
